The 1947 Dixon High School football team ended their season undefeated. In addition to achieving a perfect record of 8 wins and 0 losses, the football team won Dixon's first County football championship in 46 years. In 1901, the Dixon High School football team won Dixon High's first county championship in any sport. Under HOF Coach Kay, not only would the 1947 football team win another County football championship, it marked the beginning of Dixon's many successful football seasons and championships. The 1947 team was led by HOF players Dale Fairlee and Paul Webb.

During the regular season, the 1947 squad beat Armijo, Corning, Esparto, Clarksburg, Vacaville, Davis and Winters. They compiled a total of 182 points of offense and only allowed 7 points. Dixon played Rio Vista in the Solano County Championship. Dixon won the championship game 34 to 13.
