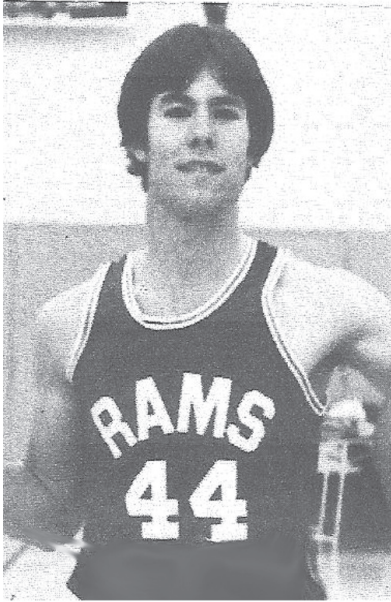


Chris Luttgies

MVP of the Sac-Joaquin Section Tournament of Champions (TOC), TOC All-Tournament team and All Northern California Team. Chris' basketball team won the Sac-Joaquin TOC in 1980 and was TOC runner-up in 1981. In 1980, The Sacramento Bee newspaper said, "Chris is possibly the best basketball player in Dixon's history." In baseball, Chris earned All League honors for two years and was named to the All Northern California Team. Chris' baseball team won the Sac-Joaquin TOC in 1980. He is the only Dixon graduated to have won the All Northern California Team honor in three different sports. Chris was selected to the Northern California Optimist All Star Game for football, basketball, and baseball. Chris was named MVP in the basketball All Star game. After graduating from Dixon High, Chris attended Whitman College in the State

of Washington on an academic scholarship. At Whitman, he participated in one year of basketball and four years of baseball. He was All Pacific Northwest his junior and senior year and led the region in hitting his junior year. After graduating from Whitman, Chris pursued a business career. Since college, Chris has been an All State Tennis Champion of Colorado, a High School basketball coach, a youth baseball, basketball and soccer coach and a Boy Scout leader.
