Dave Ball played basketball as well as football at Dixon High, where he was a three year letter winner. During Dave's senior year at Dixon High, he was selected as a football All-American, named All-Conference, won the Pop Warner Award as the top senior football player on the West Coast, and was selected as the league's football defensive player of the year. He was selected to play in the California-Texas Shrine All-Star football game and inducted into the Northern California High School Hall of Fame. Dave was also named to the First Team All-State and All-Metro (Sacramento) football teams. Dave was rated the number 12 best defensive lineman by Prep-Star magazine in the Western Region. While playing basketball, Dave was All-League his junior and senior years, his team winning the

league title in senior year. Dave averaged 15 to 20 points per game and 12 rebounds per game. Dave attended UCLA, where he played defensive end for UCLA's football team, starting for three years. He averaged 16.5 sacks a year. While at UCLA, Dave was selected the ABC Chevrolet defensive player of the year. In 2004 Dave was drafted into the NFL by the San Diego Chargers. He was later with the New York Jets and the Carolina Panthers. Dave is presently playing with the Tennessee Titans. David married Carrie Carr and has two sons Mason and Cade.
