Paul Webb lettered a combined 14 times in four sports at Dixon High School playing football, basketball, track and baseball. In 1947, Paul was named to the Football Third Team Backfield of the All-Northern California Prep Team (there was no other football recognition during these years). This honor was determined by the San Francisco Examiner newspaper polling coaches and sports writers throughout Northern California. Paul was the only person named from a small school. That year, the football team went undefeated and won the league championship. Paul played on two back to back undefeated football teams as his senior year the football team was also undefeated. Paul also played on a championship team in basketball and a championship team in track. In 1948, Paul went to the State track in Berkeley and placed 3rd in Pole Vault. This was only the third time a boy from Dixon had qualified for the State track meet. In 1949, Paul again qualified for the State track meet but was unable to attend. After high school, Paul attended San Jose State University where he ran track. Paul later worked for many years at UC Davis. He still lives in Dixon and has three children Wendy, Tina and Paul Jr.
