

Lester Rohwer

Lester Rohwer was the son of 2012 Hall of Fame Inductee Hans Rohwer. Lester was the quarterback for Dixon High football team, for which he was named All League. He was also named All League for basketball. Lester was an excellent tennis player as well.

He won the County Championship for boys' doubles in both 1933 and again in 1934. He followed in the footsteps of the rest of the Rohwer clan and was a star baseball player at Dixon High School. Lester was also on the track team. Lester went on to attend the University of California, Berkeley and graduated in 1938. He then attended Berkeley Law School.

After graduating with his law degree, Lester enlisted with the US Army Air Corps as a First Lieutenant and became a B-25 pilot.

While flying a mission over North Africa, Lester was killed in action.

Lester was married to Laurie Viser at the time of his death. He died in 1943.
